# Student Attendance

Please read the following important information from MACS. Student attendance

We are concerned about reports that there are a small number of students who may not have returned to onsite schooling this year. All students are expected to attend on site unless they are formally registered as being homeschooled.

Parents can be reassured that COVIDSafe measures are in place and that it is safe for students to attend school. Schools must ensure students with medical needs have an up-to-date health plan and accompanying condition-specific health management plan, based on individualised medical advice from the student's medical or health practitioner, and consultation with the student and parents and carers. Please note that parental preference or fear of COVID-19 is not an approved reason for students to be absent.

# **Covid Update**

Currently we have 15 students who are absent due to being Covid positive. Thank you to the parents who informed us and we hope all students and any parents with Covid recover quickly. Here is the new information relating to the provision of Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) in our school for the remainder of Term 2.

RATs will continue to be distributed to you as they have been throughout this school year for the remainder of this term.

However, from Monday 23 May 2022, we do not recommend that your child complete a RAT twice a week as previously advised.

RATs will continue to be required by students who are household contacts to attend school (five negative tests over a seven-day period) or who have symptoms.

The ongoing supply of RATs to families in our school will ensure that parents and carers have tests should they need them if their child is a household contact or has symptoms.

Families must continue to notify the Department of Health and the school if their child returns a positive RAT result. Additionally, you should inform us if any of your children are household contacts.
