

Class Liaison's

In 2023 each class will be required to have a minimum of one class liaison (2 preferable) per class. This is great news for your child and our St Mary's community!!!

The class liaison's (CL) role is to communicate with the class families to keep them connected and in touch with what's going on of importance with their children's class and around the school. If there's a significant event or any difficulties they can also reach out to help. The CL also liaises with the teacher too.

In this role you may organise a catch up for the children or a parents night out which helps build a strong class/year level community.

It's a fun and fulfilling role that will only take a small amount of time to do especially if you can share the role with another class parent. I pleased to say the majority of parents who undertook the role this year have requested to take it on again next year!
