School Arrival and School Pick-up

Arrival time: 8:30a-8:50a Pick-up time: 3:15p-3:30p

If arriving or picking up outside of these times, students must be booked into Camp Australia.

At arrival time, Parents are asked to leave promptly and allow the student to unpack their own school bag so that the students can settle with their teacher and begin the day. Even if they are upset, the teacher will look after them as most settle quickly.

Late Arrivals and Collecting Students During School Times

Should your child arrive late to school or leave early, parents are required to go to the school office and sign them in or out. Your child will then be taken to the classroom by school staff, or if leaving, be called from the classroom. You must give written permission

(officeadmin@smgreensborough.catholic.edu.au) or contact the school office (94334000) if someone other than a parent/guardian is collecting your child at any time during or after school.

Parents and Carers are not authorised to collect or drop off students directly to/from classrooms during the day as this is a safety issue.

School Absences

Parents are asked to notify the school via the Compass platform before 8.30 am on the day of their child's absence. If the school does not receive notification that a student is absent, an SMS message will be sent to the parents. A parent is then required to contact the school. If taking an extended holiday during the school term, parents/guardians must follow our "**Student Extended Holiday**" policy.

Parking & Car Park Safety

Parents may park in the William Street car park or in the car park opposite the administration building. There is a drop off/pick up zone in the William Street car park and along the side of the oval, in front of Admin and on the Oval/Roadway. <u>Parking is not permitted in any of the pick</u> <u>up/drop off zones</u>. Please do not park in the staff car park (the upper car park outside the presbytery). If parked in a mobility space it is required that you display your mobility plates. Red Rooster is private property and asks that you do not use their lot for pick-up/drop-off.






