

NOTIFICATION OF GRIMSHAW CLOSURE AFFECTING ACCESS TO ST MARY'S PARISH AND SCHOOL GROUNDS FROM 9PM FRIDAY 1 AUGUST TO 5AM MONDAY 4 AUGUST

This weekend from 9pm Friday 1 August to 5am Monday 4 August, the access to St Mary's School and Parish will be via William St due to the North East Link Project closure of Grimshaw Street in both directions between Greensborough Bypass and Adeline/Williams Street. Detours will be in place via Greensborough Bypass and Diamond Creek Road with delays of up to 15 minutes expected.


