Closure to Grimshaw St Updates



In October, for four weeks there will be full closure of Grimshaw St from the Greensborough Bypass to William Street. NELP has advised the school that the major interruption to traffic will be one week of the four weeks. We have devised a contingency plan for entrance into the school via William St. Attached is the map and clear directions that must be adhered to for clear traffic flow. We also request everyone to be patient and understanding as drop off and pick up may take longer than usual. I am meeting with NELP personnel on Thursday 11th September. I will ensure any updates provided to me in relation to road closures or access to the school are shared with you immediately so that you can plan your trips accordingly.

Infrastructure Update

We are still in the tender process for the refurbishment of the two storey building. The builders have been shortlisted to two. We have decanted the building in readiness for the program to begin. Shortly we will be providing our Maintenance team with a new facility as they currently work out of the end of the two storey building. I will update you with any further information as soon as it becomes available. We do not yet have a firm start date.

The BV FDP is aligned with and underpins the teaching and philosophies of the National Performance Pathway. Traffic Safety

All cars will be requested to move on after a reasonable amount of time if your child is not present at *Kiss and Drop* after the dismissal bell.

Just a reminder that all students must exit their vehicles on the left hand side of the car at the Admin drop off area. This is a safety issue due to cars occasionally overtaking at that time and thus compromising the safety of our students.
